

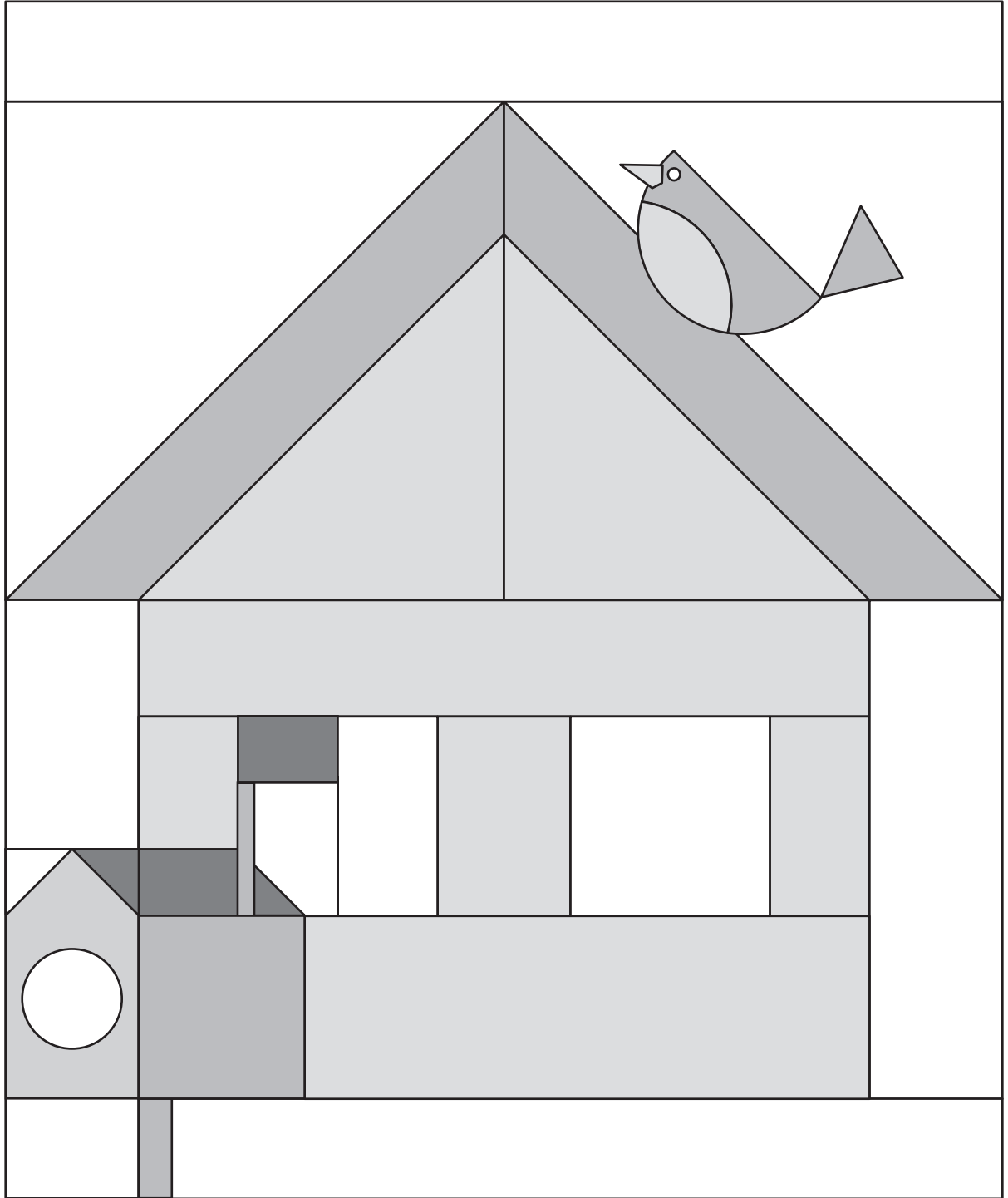

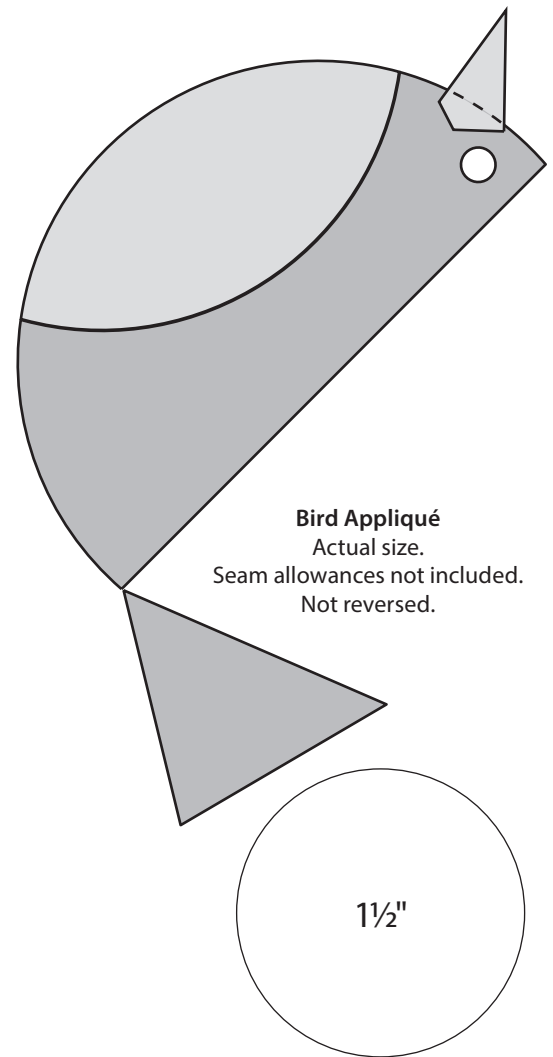
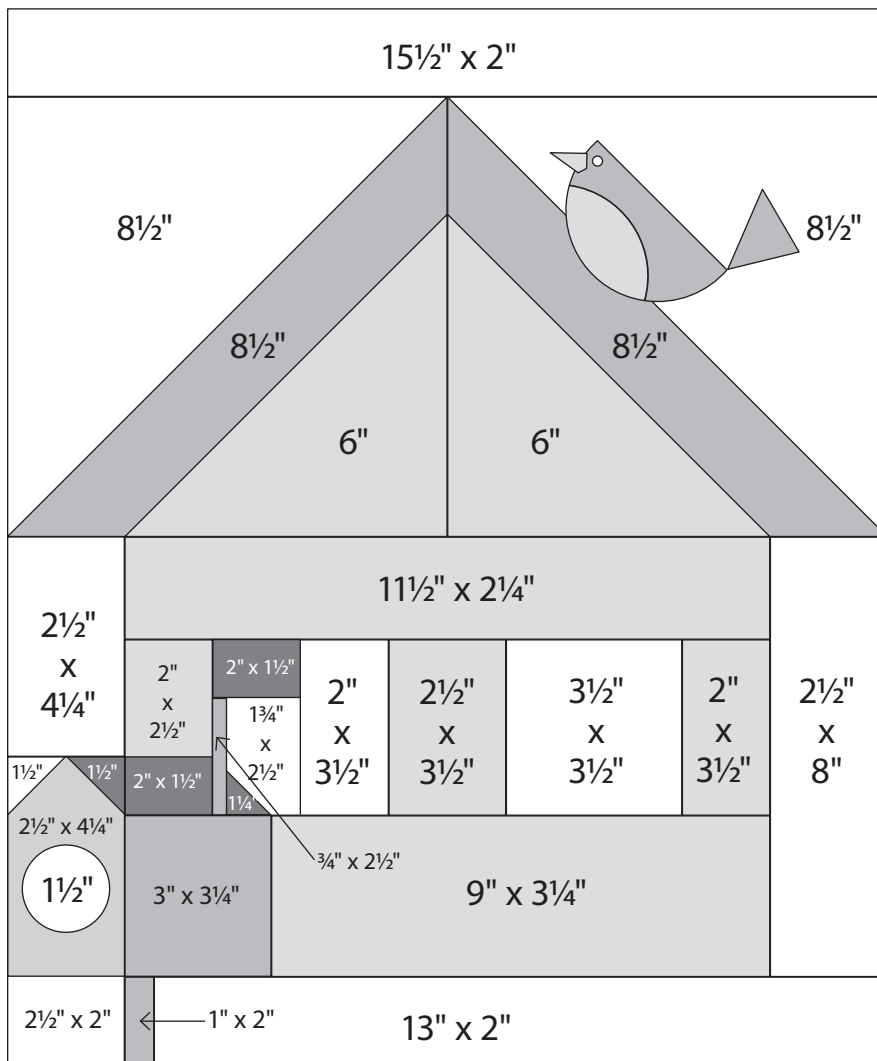

Cutting

House

- 1-11 1/2" x 2 1/4" rectangle
- 1-9" x 3 1/4" rectangle
- 2-6" squares
- 1-2 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangle
- 1-2" x 3 1/2" rectangle
- 1-2" x 2 1/2" rectangle

House Roof

- 1-8 1/2" square
cut in half once on the diagonal to make 2 half-square triangles

Mailbox Front

- 1-2 1/2" x 4 1/4" rectangle
- 1-1 1/2" circle

Mailbox Side and Pole

- 1-3" x 3 1/4" rectangle
- 1-1" x 2" rectangle

Mailbox Roof

- 1-1 1/4" square
- 1-1 1/2" square
- 1-2" x 1 1/2" rectangle

Windows

- 1-3 1/2" square
- 1-2" x 3 1/2" rectangle
- 1-1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangle

Flag

- 1-2 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangle

Flag Pole

- 1-3/4" x 2 1/2" rectangle

Bird Appliqué

- 1-beak
- 1-body
- 1-tail
- 1-wing
- 1-eye

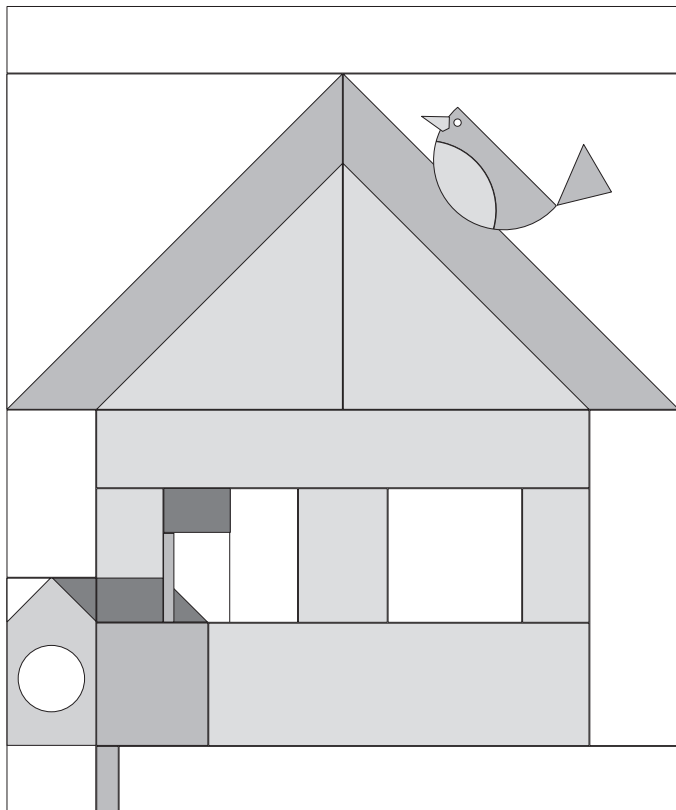
Background

- 1-15 1/2" x 2" rectangle
- 1-13" x 2" rectangle
- 1-8 1/2" square
cut in half once on the diagonal to make 2 half-square triangles
- 1-2 1/2" x 8" rectangle
- 1-2 1/2" x 4 1/4" rectangle
- 1-2 1/2" x 2" rectangle
- 1-1 1/2" square

Block 3 is 15" x 18" finished.

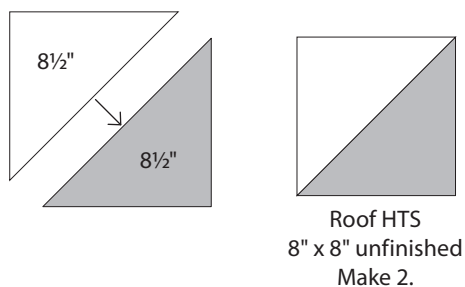


Construction

Use $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams. Press in the direction of the arrows in the diagrams.

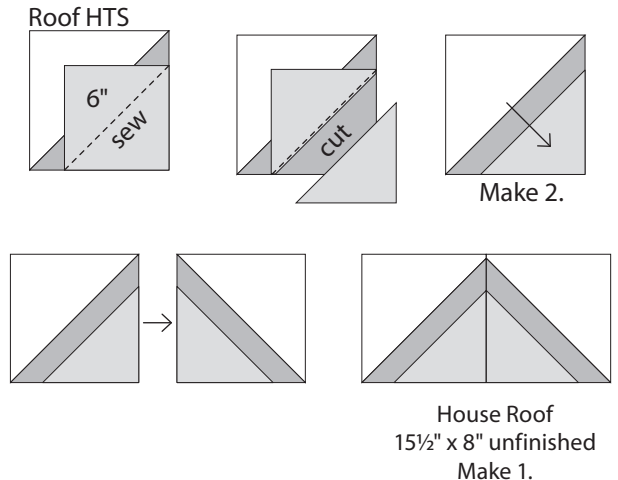
1 House Roof

(A) Join one $8\frac{1}{2}$ " roof and one $8\frac{1}{2}$ " background half-square triangle to make one half-triangle square (HTS). Make 2. Trim to 8".



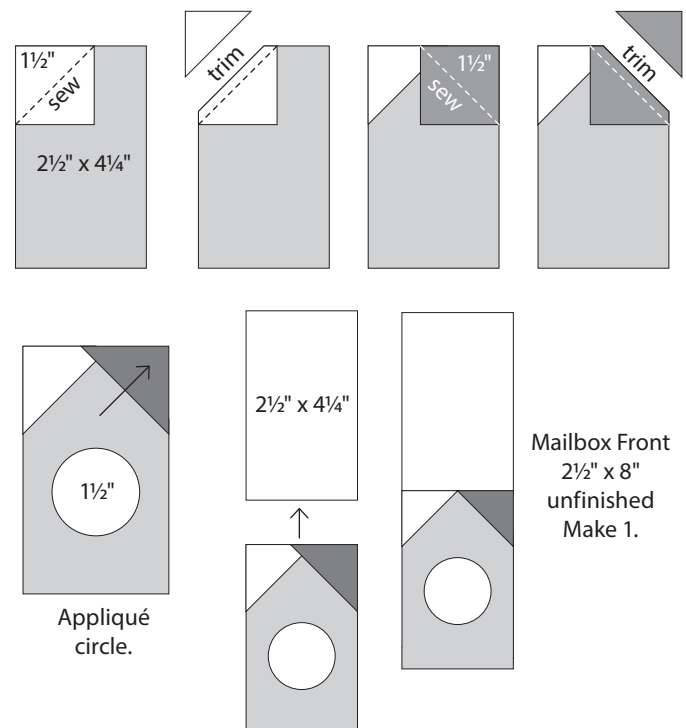

HOUSE ROOF CONTINUED . . .

(B) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 2–6" house squares. Layer a marked house square, right sides to together, on a roof HTS as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim the 6" house square only, $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the diagonal line. Press to reveal the triangle. Make 2. Join to make the house roof.



2 Mailbox

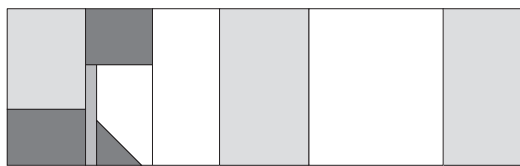
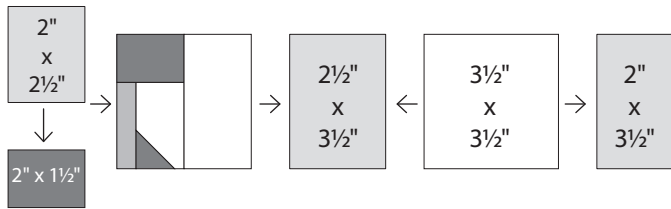
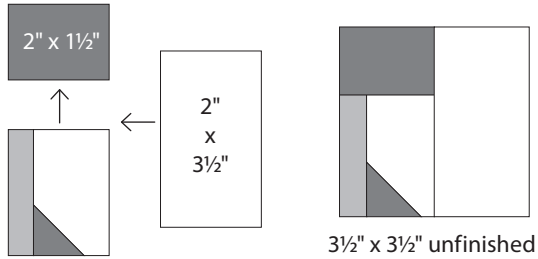
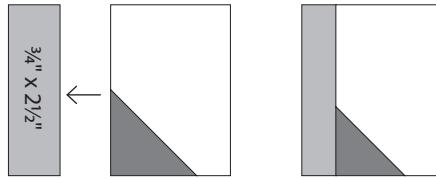
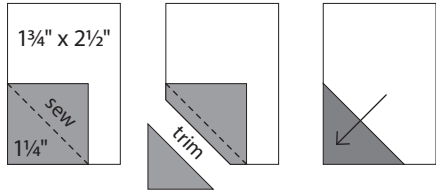
Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 1– $1\frac{1}{2}$ " background and 1– $1\frac{1}{2}$ " mailbox roof squares. Layer a marked background square, right sides to together, on the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ " mailbox front as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the diagonal line. Press to reveal the triangle. Repeat using the marked $1\frac{1}{2}$ " mailbox square on the opposite corner as shown. Appliqué the circle to the front. Add a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ " background rectangle as shown.



3 MAILBOX FLAG AND HOUSE WINDOWS

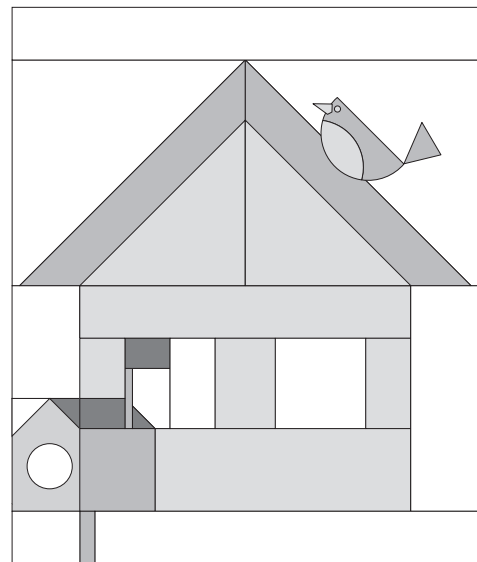
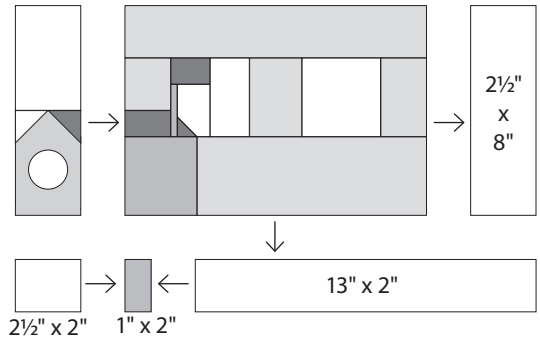
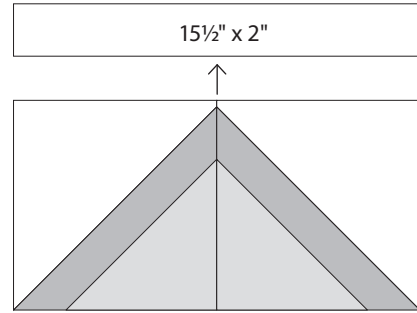
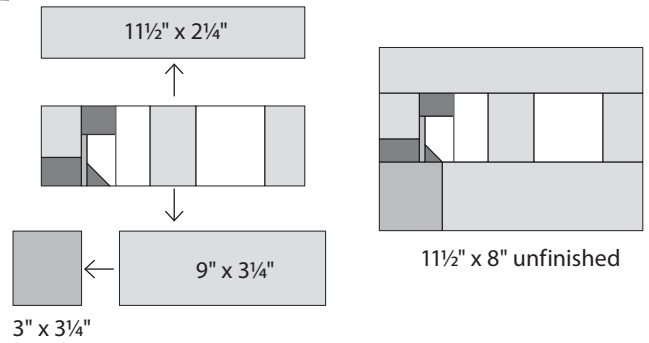
Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 1-1/4" mailbox roof square. Layer the marked square, right sides to together, on the 1 3/4" x 2 1/2" window as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim 1/4" from the diagonal line. Press to reveal the triangle.

Follow the steps to assemble the mailbox flag and house windows.
